



Kendal Snowsports Club - Members Declaration

I understand the role of club slope officials in supervising slope safety and will abide by their instruction when given.
I understand the value of warming up and getting a feel for how the slope is running/my kit is performing before increasing the difficulty of any skiing/boarding.
I understand that very warm and icy conditions can have an adverse effect on how the slope surface runs and that wind can affect the use of terrain.
I understand slope etiquette and safety including: ○ Looking up, the slope prior to commencing a run. ○ Skiing/boarding to the conditions of the slope and my ability. ○ No cutting in on the lift queues ○ No having a rest at the bottom of the slope, move into the gallery. ○ How to use the emergency stop on a tow in case of emergency
I know where to find the Code of Conduct for members located on the club website and the lodge notice board and will adhere to them when using the slope.
I understand that when the slope is busy, that I will tailor my skiing/boarding to a level that is not a potential risk to other users of the slope.
I understand that if I intend to join the freestyle sessions in the future, I shall watch the freestyle induction video and read the freestyle Induction and Freestyle Declaration.
I understand that skiing/boarding activities are inherently dangerous and there is a risk of injury even by those well practiced.
I understand that all juniors under 12 years of age must be supervised by an adult.
